In 2011, three villages in the larger Loire AOC of Muscadet Sèvre & Maine were given cru status elevating them above the rank and file of Muscadet. The best of these is Clisson, a village where granite soils concentrate the flavours of the Melon grape brilliantly. The Perraud brothers belong to the new school of Loire vignerons who have wholeheartedly embraced sustainable and organic viticulture but who have taken the additional step of cellar-ageing their wines on the lees for over forty months resulting in a wine that completely transcends its humble origins. Superb with oysters, white-fleshed fishes and cheeses, this wine is a monument to minerality.

Nobody rides the fence on Gewurztraminer. People love it or hate it. But even those who like it often won't order it in a restaurant because they're not sure how sweet that particular bottle will be. The 'Lyra' is fully dry but possesses those rich, flowery aromas and flavours that Gewurtz lovers swoon over. The Nals Margreid winery is one of the best producers in Alto Adige, a feat made more remarkable by the fact they are also a cooperative representing 150 small growers, the best-run cooperative I have ever seen. If you're skeptical, check out their website and see how gorgeous their winery is! These folks know how to spend their money. Try this heady white with tuna tartare or chicken.

Matt Brain and Josh Baker take sustainability very seriously, with a solar-powered winery and recycled materials for everything including labels and lightweight bottles. Brain, a native of Georgetown, Ontario, who teaches enology at Cal-Poly and Baker, the winemaker at Edna Valley Vineyards, met on a camping trip in Yosemite and bonded over a discussion on low-impact, high-quality winemaking. They specialize in esoteric grape choices and found this small patch of Gruner in the Paragon Vineyard, the most prestigious vineyard in San Luis Obispo. Rich and heady aromatically, this plush but unoaked offering goes so well with just about everything, itself almost a testament to multiculturalism.

There is a theory that the ancient Minoan culture on Crete may have been destroyed by a tsunami created by a massive volcanic explosion on neighbouring Santorini. What is certain is that the soil on Santorini is fairly young and very volcanic with high levels of ambient sulfur. What this means, where winemaking is concerned, is that depending on natural yeasts for barrel fermentation is more perilous here than almost anywhere else. Gaia winemaker (and University of Bordeaux enology professor) Dr. Yiannis Paraskevopoulos estimates he loses one-third of his 'Wild Ferment' barrels each year due to stuck fermentations, which is a bloody shame because this is easily Greece's best white wine. Made from the intensely mineral grape Assyrtiko, this tastes like Cru-level white Burgundy made with a hammer. Very cool stuff.

Seldom seen outside of France until around a decade ago, Sancerre Rouge has become a staple of sommeliers who love French Pinot Noirs and want to share a reasonably priced example. Burgundy may indeed remain the motherlode for Pinot but Sancerre Rouge is farmed the same way on similar limestone soils and is a great alternative wine for the classic style of French cooking that we undertake to provide here. This will go with red meats and richer fishes but may hit its best expression with dishes like steak tartare, duck and charcuterie.

This estate is the property of Trevor Gulliver, Ferguson Henderson's partner in London's famous St. John restaurant. The vines for it are actually in Minervois' prestigious La Livinière commune but cannot be called that because by making a 100% Carignane, they have broken the rules for the AOC. Dense, graphitic blue fruit with the scent of crushed white sunblasted rock makes this a great partner for lamb and red meat braises but if you like your reds oak-free and chewy, this may be ideal for you. Savoury and delicious.

Dense and brooding with deep reserves of blue-black fruit, this classic Priorat is a blend of 60% Garnacha, 25% Syrah and the remainder made up of Merlot and Cabernet Sauvignon all biodynamically grown from vines averaging about twenty years of age. It has seen time in oak but the 4,000 litre barrels do not transfer much in the way of oak flavouring to the finished wine.

This is a great accompaniment to all types of game, lamb and beef, and is particularly good with deep braises and tomato dishes.

Italian wine has changed so much since the formation of the EU! When Bordeaux varietals became legal in Tuscany in the 80s, it just felt like such a cynical move. But, I have to admit that my misgivings were wrong. In the hands of some vigneroni, Cabernet and especially Merlot have shown to be excellent additions when not used to overstuff Sangiovese blends. This Maremma Toscana is Cabernet and Merlot with small amounts of Montepulciano and Bouschet Alicante. Like a slightly rustic St Emilion with subtle notes of game and barnyard. Delicious!
