This tiny 160 acre appellation due north of Vouvray was lionized by the enthusiastic tippler Charles VI in the Middle Ages but has only recently become popular again, mostly in the wine bars and bistros of Paris. Like Vouvray, it is 100% Chenin Blanc grown on similar chalk and clay soils and is remarkably ageworthy. Pleasantly crisp with classic yellow apple and dried papaya aromas with that classic whiff of wet Harris tweed! If you like Vouvray, you'll be delighted with this.

Nobody rides the fence on Gewurztraminer. People love it or hate it. But even those who like it often won't order it in a restaurant because they're not sure how sweet that particular bottle will be. The 'Lyra' is fully dry but possesses those rich, flowery aromas and flavours that Gewurtz lovers swoon over. The Nals Margreid winery is one of the best producers in Alto Adige, a feat made more remarkable by the fact they are also a cooperative representing 150 small growers, the best-run cooperative I have ever seen. If you're skeptical, check out their website and see how gorgeous their winery is! These folks know how to spend their money. Try this heady white with tuna tartare or chicken.

Charles Baker has been one of Canada's best ambassadors for Ontario Riesling since he left Jamie Kennedy's Palmerston restaurant to work at Cave Spring Cellars in 1994. He worked continually to put Cave Spring wines on winelists in far flung hubs like New York and London and even here in Toronto when there was little local faith in our re nascent wine region. When Stratus offered him the chance to make his own Rieslings under their aegis in 2005, he leapt at the chance and Charles Baker Wines was born. Considered annually always in the the top two or three Canadian Rieslings, the Picone Vineyard bottling has been a mainstay on the Scaramouche list since it was first produced. Wonderful with white-fleshed fish and calamari, smoked meats and almost anything with ginger, soy and even wasabi. Kudos!

There is a theory that the ancient Minoan culture on Crete may have been destroyed by a tsunami created by a massive volcanic explosion on neighbouring Santorini. What is certain is that the soil on Santorini is fairly young and very volcanic with high levels of ambient sulfur. What this means, where winemaking is concerned, is that depending on natural yeasts for barrel fermentation is more perilous here than almost anywhere else. Gaia winemaker (and University of Bordeaux enology professor) Dr. Yiannis Paraskevopoulos estimates he loses one-third of his 'Wild Ferment' barrels each year due to stuck fermentations, which is a bloody shame because this is easily Greece's best white wine. Made from the intensely mineral grape Assyrtiko, this tastes like Cru-level white Burgundy made with a hammer. Very cool stuff.

In 2007, Jean-Pascal Sarnin quit his job as CFO at a large Paris stockbrokers firm and moved back to his hometown of St-Romain. Jean-Marie Berrux had too left a successful career in advertising in 1999 to pursue winemaking. Together, they are emblematic of a new Burgundy, making wines as naturally as possible - unfiltered, without added yeasts or enzymes and using the minimum legal sulfur to stabilize their organic Pinots. This results in a lovely purity with vivid intensity and a very good midpalate and finish.

This wine is made by Trevor Gulliver, one of the partners in the excellent Saint John restaurant group in London. It is classic old vine Carignan from La Livinière, the finest village cru in Corbières, made with as little intervention as possible and the only reason that it's a lowly VdP is because the makeup of 100% Carignan defies the AOC regulations that stipulates a blend. Dark with glossy, mineral-tinged black fruit, it's delicious with lamb, venison, tomato dishes and charcuterie.

Owner/winemaker Mark Vlossak founded St. Innocent in 1988 and has been one of the leading lights of the Oregon Pinot movement throughout its existence. All of his wines had always been single vineyard bottlings until about ten years ago when he created the 'Villages' cuvée which is a blend of fruit from all five of his vineyards. Fresh and juicy, a little lighter than his vineyard-designated Pinots, this wine is meant to go with lighter foods like roast chicken or gamebirds and is gorgeous with robust fishes like salmon as well.

Bodega Chacra is the brainchild of Piero Incisa della Rocchetta, the grandson of the creator of Tuscany's Sassicaia. The Barda cuvée is from a twenty-seven year old biodynamically farmed vineyard in the Patagonian desert. The key to making superb Pinot here is the diurnal temperature swing between warm sunny days that ripen grapes perfectly and crisp nighttime temperatures that retain freshness and balance. Nice intensity here that pairs beautifully with duck, veal and even richer fishes like salmon.
